Reminder: The priority group that should get the flu shot first are:

- Children aged six months to under 18 years old
- Anyone of Aboriginal ancestry (First Nations, Métis or Inuit)
- Disadvantaged individuals (for example, homeless)
- People under 65 with a severe chronic medical condition or other risks including severe obesity, substance abuse or alcoholism
- Anyone with a weakened immune system or those who live with or care for them
- Pregnant women
- Those who live with or care for infants under six months old
- Single parents or anyone solely responsible for a dependent
- Health care workers and medical first responders

Please Wait If You Are Not in a Priority Group

If you are not in one of the priority groups listed above, please wait until more vaccine arrives and let those in the priority groups receive their shots now. As more vaccine arrives, the H1N1 shot will be offered at flu shot clinics to other Manitobans who need or want it.
